TVH reported no new positive test results as of today. However, limits in testing continue to be an issue. A committee including hospital staff and members of the public are currently working on procuring rapid testing equipment. Details of that project will be provided as soon as possible. The clinics in Driggs and Victor are open for regular hours. Screeners are in place at both locations and will screen everyone prior to entry. We would like to remind everyone to take care of themselves in every way possible. If you are ill, please do not hesitate in seeking care.
