## Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) Renewal:

Commissioners, along with Local 4667 representatives and Chief Campbell discussed each of the items under consideration in the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA). Edits and suggestions from the July 17<sup>th</sup> meetings were used to further discuss each topic at today's meeting.

Items further discussed today by Local 4667 and Fire Commissioners were:

- 1. COLA
- 2. Medic Pay
- 3. Safe Staffing
- 4. Year in Rank Pay
- 5. Physicals

- 6. PTO Scheduling
- 7. 40 hour week pay scale for Wildland Assignments and Light Duty
- 8. 24 hours of PTO vs. 48 before utilizing Long Term Sick
- 9. Step-up pay, Article 30, page 22
- 10. Personnel reduction, Article 11, page 9

Items affecting the proposed budget up for approval on August 14<sup>th</sup>, were discussed to conclusion at the end of the meeting. It was agreed that the base wage increase for year one would be 1.25%, and would be based on COLA for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year of the CBA, (Article 19, page 16 Wages & Compensation). It was further agreed to amend the Paramedic Certification Pay, (Article 19, page 17, section four) to receive an additional 10% of the senior firefighter's base pay for those with EMT-P licensure. These were done in order to have a proposed budget for the August 14<sup>th</sup> Budget Hearing meeting. The remaining items will be discussed in the next meeting, schedule for August 14<sup>th</sup>, after the public budget hearing concludes.
