Capital Improvement Plan:

The Fire Commissioners toured the station to discuss the remodel and the repairs the station needs. Commissioner Foster mentioned a new property that might be appropriate for a new station. The discussion continued on the design and funding of the remodel/repairs.

City of Victor Inspection Fees:

Chief Giles has been working on scheduling a meeting with the City of Victor staff to discuss the inspection fees. The Commissioners would like to join the meeting as well. The meeting has been scheduled for May 26.

Vehicle Optimization Inventory:

Chief Hoyle presented an inventory report to the Commissioners. He would like directions on how to proceed forward. He would like to get rid of the Tender 3, stationed at Station #3. ARRF would be the next one to be disposed of. Commissioner Foster said to go ahead and list them.

EMS Equipment Grant:

Commissioners were asked to sign the endorsement letter for the EMS Grant.

Commissioner Vacancy:

One application has been received so far. The deadline for the applications is Friday, June 10.

Budget Narratives:

Chief Schauster has been working with each division Chief to create a budget narrative for each department. A description of the budget was presented to the Commissioners. The Commissioners would like to have each Division Chief present the budget by June 14.

CBA Contract:

Aaron Stiny spoke on Cola adjustments and station remodel. He would like to revisit the wage study once the contract expires. Both Commissioners and the Local are worried about inflation and how housing cost could affect the staff. Per Contract a 3% COLA increase will be added to the wages along with a 3.5% increase per wage study Phase II.

Chief's Report:

Chief Maltaverne reported that he was happy with the department's outreach in the community. Chief Giles is still receiving a high number of building permits. Chief Schauster let the Commissioners know about the upcoming Training Exercise on May 19.

Commissioner Foster made a motion to adjourn at 1745 hours.
